**THE ASSAM COLLEGE EMPLOYEES (PROVINCIALISATION)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 2012**

further to amend the Assam College Employees (Provincialisation) (Amendment) Act, 2005.

Preamble

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Assam College Employees (Provincialisation) Act, 2005, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in the manner, hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

**Short title, extent
and
commencement**

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam College Employees (Provincialisation) (Amendment) Act, 2012.
- (2) It shall have the like extent as the principal Act.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.

**Amendment
of section 3**

2. In the principal Act, in section 3
(i) for the existing clause (c), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“(C) the posts in each provincialised College shall constitute as independent cadre for each category of employees except the post of Principals of Colleges. All Principals of provincialised College shall form an independent common cadre. Save and except the cadre of principals, no inter cadre transfer from one College to another including mutual transfer shall be allowed. The services of the Principals shall be transferrable among the Colleges.”;

- (ii) in clause (d), for the existing proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely :-

“Provided that the option once exercised by an existing or retired employee may be withdrawn by him at any time if he wants to come under provincialisation under the Act, subject to the refund of the amount of Government’s share of the Contributory Provident Fund with interest thereon up to the date of refund of Government’s share of the Contributory Provident Fund with interest thereon:

Provided further that the withdrawal of option shall be effective on the date of refund of the amount of the Government’s share of the Contributory Provident Fund with interest;”
