Sir,


In pursuance of the Govt. letter under reference above, I like to inform you that the Govt. of Assam, Education (Higher) Department has decided to allow the Provincialised College authorities to use 30% tuition fee income for the purpose of contingencies expenditure like payment of electricity bill, development of infrastructure of the college, sanitation and other day to day expenditure.

In this connection, it may be pointed out that, if some colleges have already utilized the collected tuition fees without Govt. permission they are advised to adjust the amount from their 30% tuition fees.

Further, all the principals cum D.D.O.'s of Provincialised Colleges are advised to deposit their 70% of Govt. share of tuition fee in the separate account year wise since 2007 to 2013 and submit a report to the undersigned showing the accounts no. and amount deposited in the particular account for further transmission of the matter to the Govt. of Assam immediately.

Please treat the matter as top most urgent and submit compliance report within 15 days from the date of issue of the letter.


